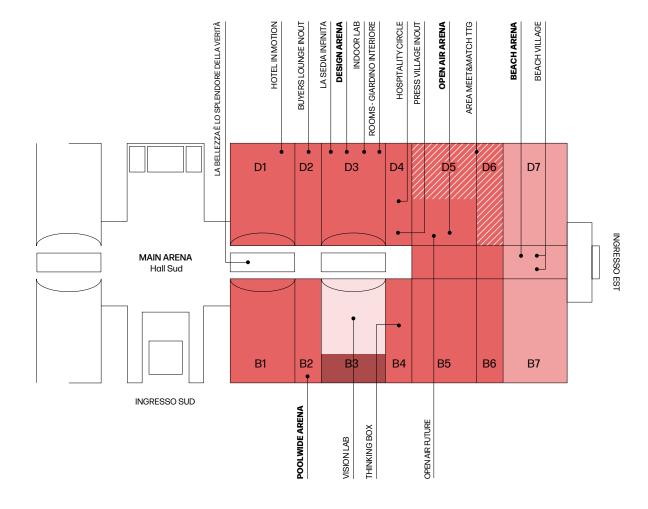

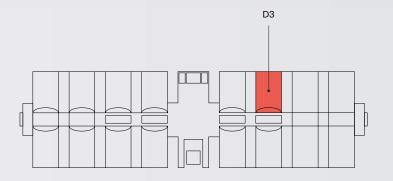

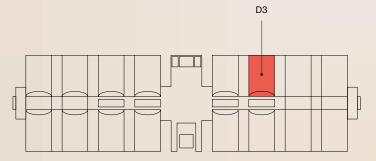

#### Rooms - Giardino interiore / Rooms - Inner garden: the fourth dimension of hospitality

While today's hotels have vastly elevated the guest experience to a concrete, textured and aesthetic level, Rooms - Inner Garden invites us to go further, adding the design of sensations to the customer experience, rooted in the dialogue between the natural and artificial worlds. Every sense is taken care of here, where feeling becomes the fourth dimension of hospitality. The project comprises a single route consisting of four installations that explore different concepts of hospitality for the future: Breathing, **Listening, Walking and Touch**. Unsurprisingly, the names are both nouns and verbs: they invite us to do something and at the same time to be in the space, outside and inside the self.

#### La sedia infinita / The Infinite Chair

by ADI Design Museum - Milan, curated by Maite García Sanchis

In an industry like hospitality, where the customer experience is fundamental, The Infinite Chair exhibition offers a unique opportunity for professionals to better understand **the potential of furniture design** and how this can improve the overall guest experience.

At InOut|The Contract Community, The Infinite Chair by the ADI Design Museum in Milan explores how the chair has evolved over the last 70 years, through **40 iconic chairs of industrial design**. Curated by architect Maite García Sanchis, the exhibition groups the chairs into pairs or thematic groups, highlighting innovation and transformation in design. Some of the chairs exhibited were winners of the prestigious Compasso d'Oro award, celebrating authenticity in design, including *Up* by Gaetano Pesce and *Superleggera* by Gio Ponti. The exhibition also reveals the creative and technical processes behind these creations, presenting a number of chairs in an unconventional way.

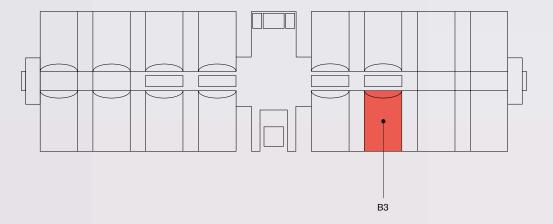

#### NATURE AND ARTIFICE

"Nature and Artifice" welcomes visitors to the hall, with the wow factor guaranteed. Reflecting on the **relationship between man and nature**, the installation is made from recycled and ecofriendly materials. The oval space, a metaphor for a forest, creates a meditative environment, where light and smells evoke natural well-being. This installation was created by the **eclectic architect Rotella**, famed for his work that is always imbued with deep meanings, and which through metaphors and symbols invites us to reflect on the rules that define nature and its relationship with man.

#### **GARDEN SUITE**

Romantic and private extension of rooms with an exclusive and protected external view, a truly privileged Eden for guests in search of continuity between the indoors and outdoors, with no filter. A space of **beauty**, **total comfort and absolute privacy.** 

#### **LOVE BOAT**

An elegant and exclusive concept for tourist accommodation by the sea, designed to offer comfort and spectacular views from dawn to dusk.

#### **GREEN POP**

Multi-coloured setting to ensure In&Out is a lively experience. A space ready to become a reference point for **enjoyable social occasions** thanks to the careful **selection of materials, fabrics, complements and accessories, and a careful selection of plants and flowers.** 

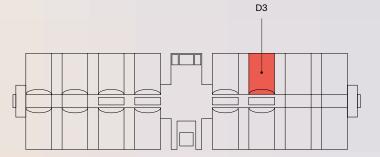
#### **RURAL CHIC GARDEN**

Proposing eco-friendly accommodation that looks to country estates, farmhouses and rural destinations providing accommodation for weddings, events and breaks in the country.

Away from the hustle and bustle of the city, lots of ideas for equipped spaces, social spaces and barbecue areas.

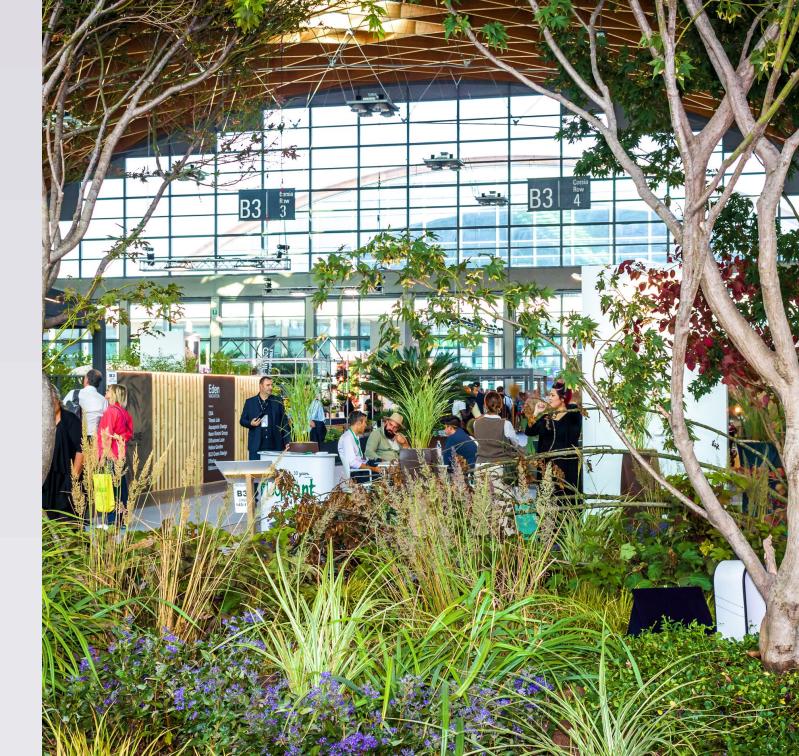

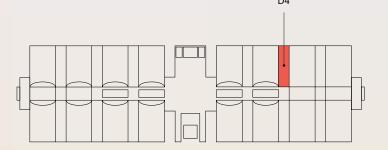

#### **Hospitality Circle**

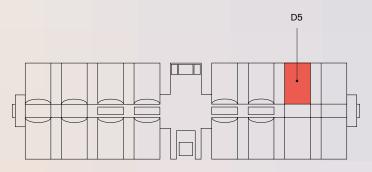

Hospitality Circle is a scenic installation dedicated to the world of hospitality, an exhibition with a museum-like approach, which explores visually and functionally a concept dear to the architect's heart: **translating the complexity of our times into simple solutions**, offering inspiration for innovative and successful accommodation through **constant cross-contamination between figures**, **light**, **words and unexpected functions**.



The installation consists of five macro wings, marked by by **circular two-dimensional geometrical shapes**, creating thematic areas imagined to showcase products with a high aesthetic, technological and functional value selected by architect Simone Micheli.

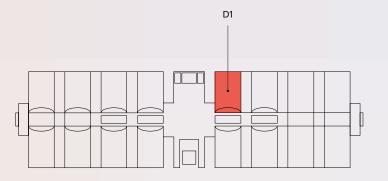
## Open Air Future, futuristic architecture for extreme outdoor experiences

Open Air Future showcases the prototype of the architectural project [TREE]SHIP, designed by Paolo Scoglio's architecture studio THE NE[S]T, within the [X]SHIP Extreme Sustainable Human Innovative Pod, research and development programme, intended to explore the most extreme sustainable solutions in experiential outdoor tourism.

[TREE]SHIP represents the perfect synthesis of love for nature and technological innovation, which has always been the stylistic hallmark of the internationally recognised Italian studio.



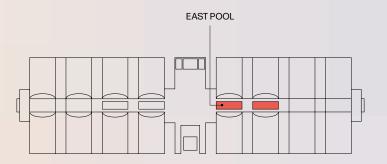

## La Bellezza è lo Splendore della Verità / Beauty is the Splendour of Truth

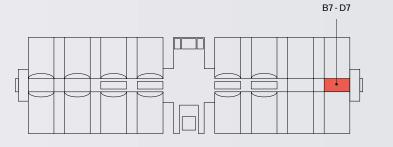

#### Beach Village

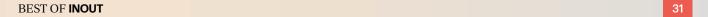

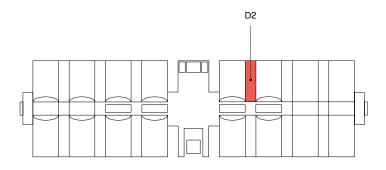
